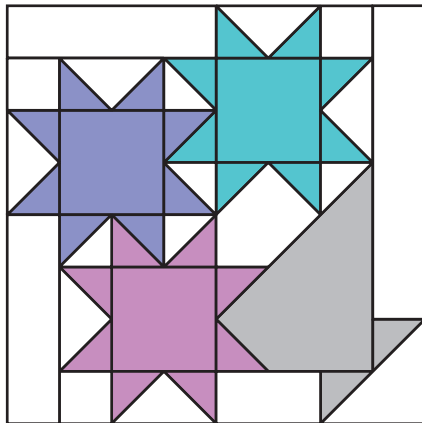
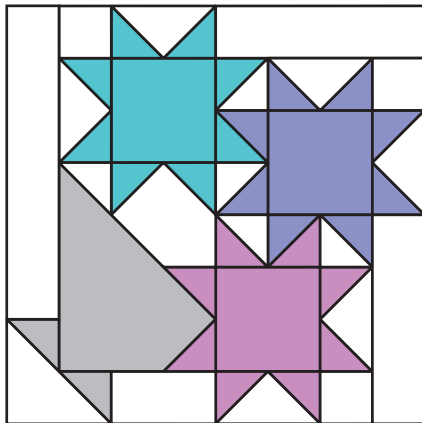

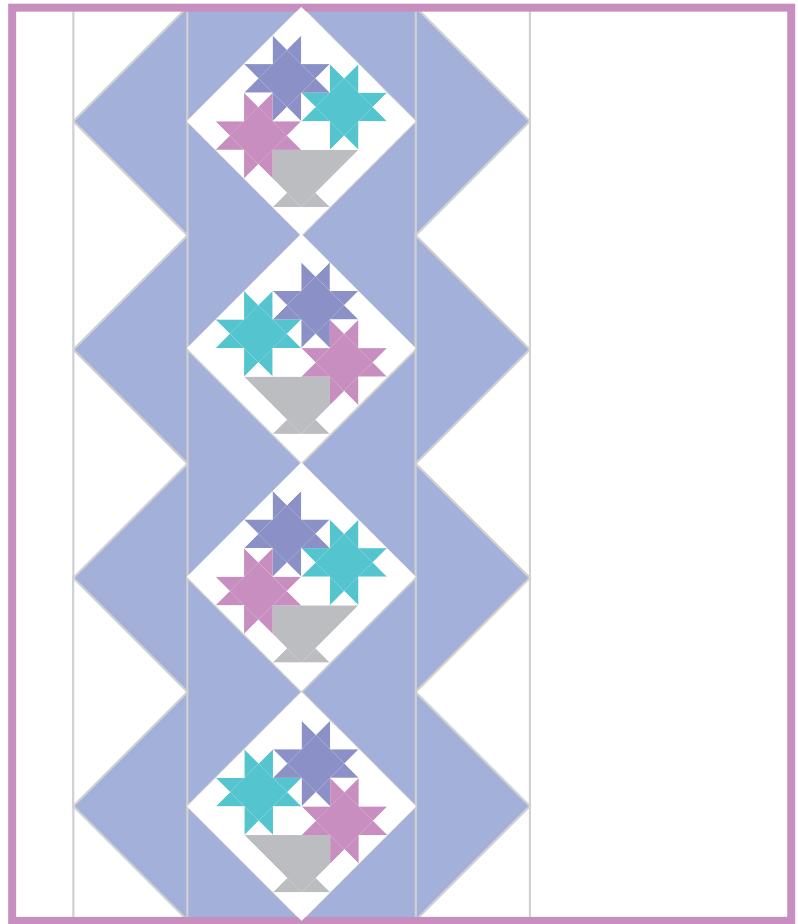

## Yardage

1 Fat Quarter or 1/4 Yd. Each of Blue-Green, Dark Blue-Violet, and Red-Violet:

4 A and 32 C from each

1 Fat Quarter Gray:

2 F, 2 Fr ( F reversed), 8 C

2 5/8 Yards White:

1 M, 1 N, 6 K, 4 L, 4 H, 8 J, 4 I, 4 G,

4 E, 24 B, 20 C, and 12 D

1 3/8 Yards Periwinkle

14 K, 4 L

4 Yards Backing

1/2 Yard Fabric to Make Binding

## Rotary Cutting Patches

(shown at right and on next 2 pages)

A, B, C, D, F, I, K, and L are cut from squares as shown.

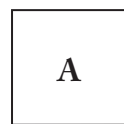
B, C, F, I, K, and L are further cut to make half-square or quarter-square triangles. The quantity listed is the number of triangles, not the number of squares.

**E and F/Fr are described in detail at right.**

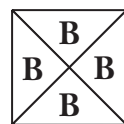
M: Cut 1 white strip 5" x 68 1/2".

N: Cut 1 white strip 21" x 68 1/2".

M & N dimensions include no extra.

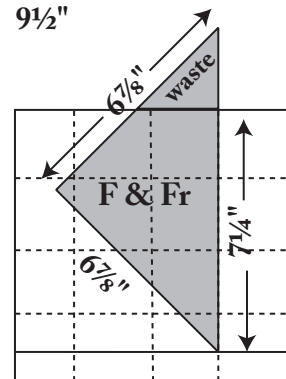
E: Cut a 2 5/8" x 3 7/8" rectangle.



Finished E

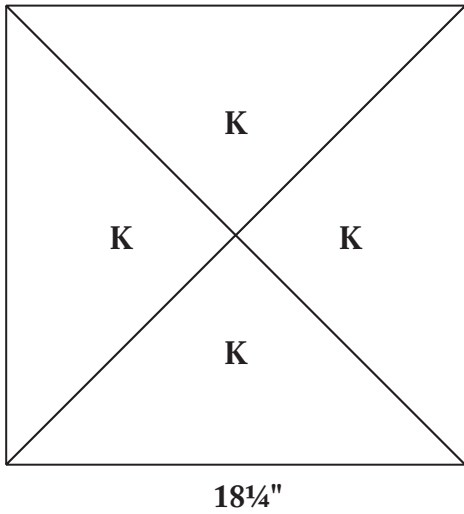


E: Cut and tape the E template to corner of rotary ruler. Align E template with 3 sides of fabric. Cut off excess fabric. (Fabric is white, but it is shown in yellow for contrast.)

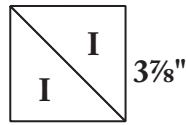


F: Cut two 6 7/8" squares of fabric. Cut each square in half diagonally to make 2 triangles. Layer 2 triangles face up and 2 face down. Align long edge of triangles with a vertical line of a rotary ruler. Also align point with 7 1/4" horizontal ruling. Cut off waste to make 2 F & 2 F reversed.

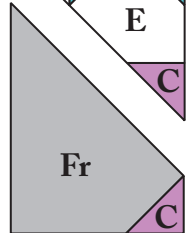
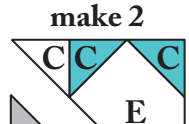
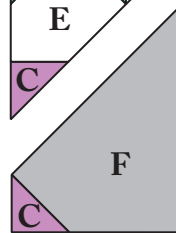
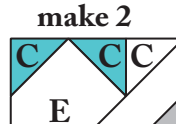
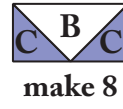
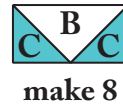
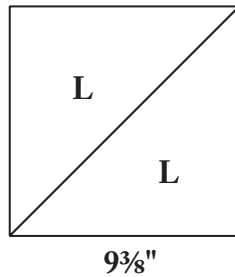

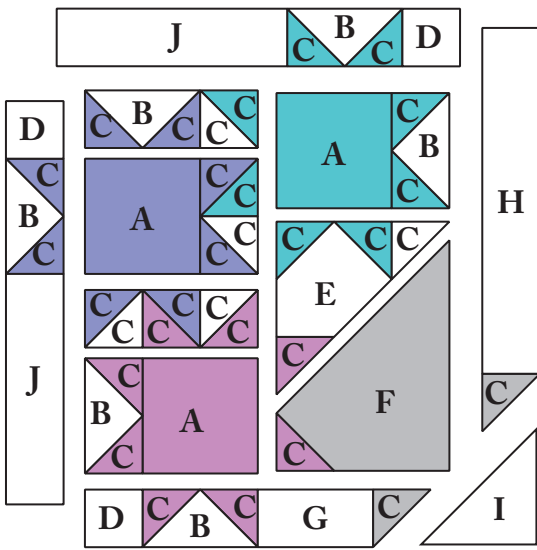
Piece units as shown; then join units and patches to make blocks.



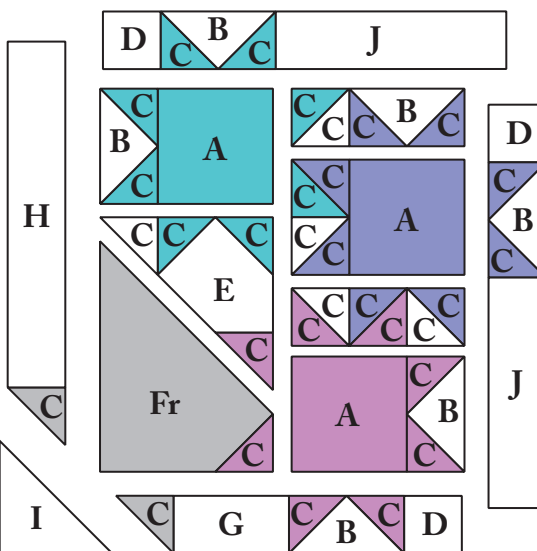

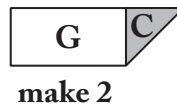


Block Y Piecing (make 2)

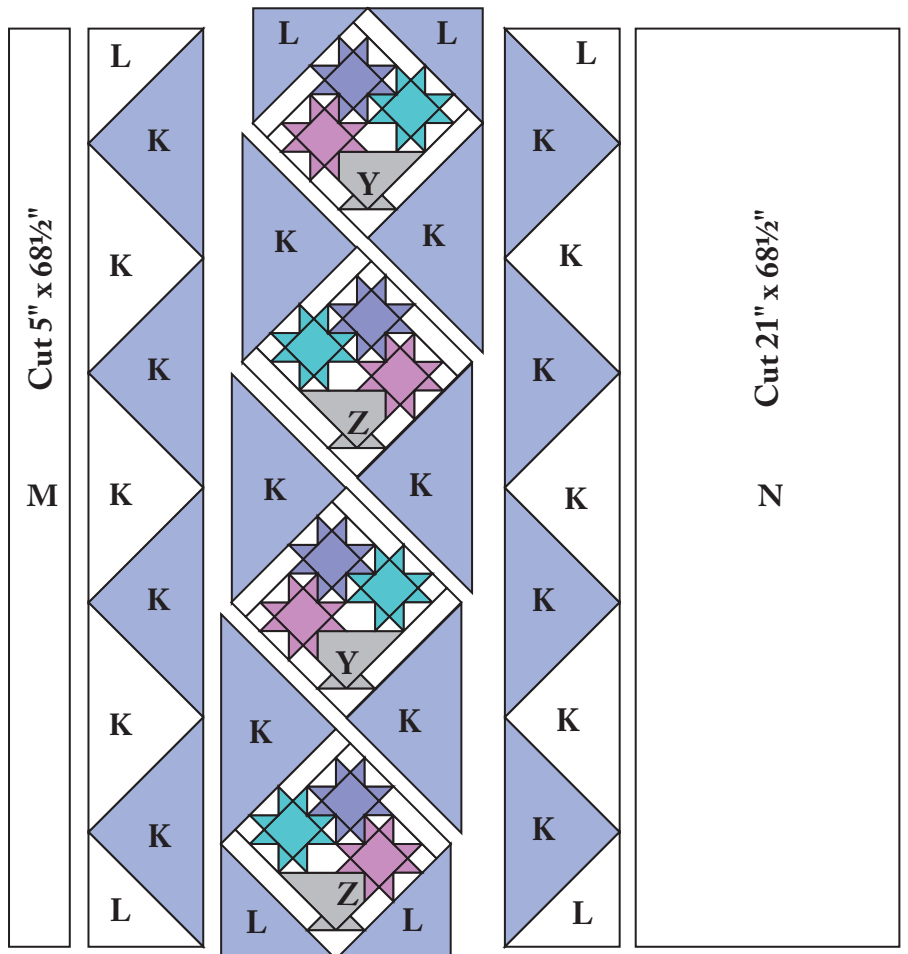


Block Z Piecing (make 2)

C-C units are 2" and C-B-C units are 2" x 3 1/2" from raw edge to raw edge.

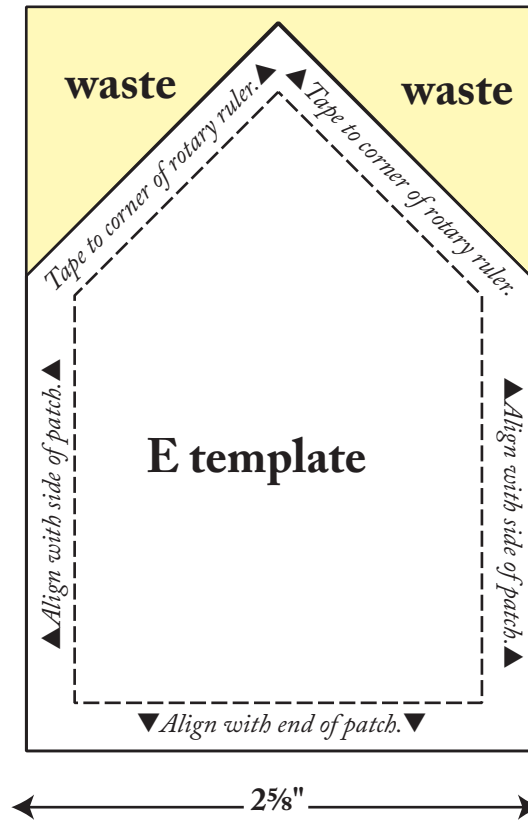


You may make the Flying Geese units (C-B-C) and half-square triangle units (C-C) with your choice of method, but you may need a little extra yardage if you do so.
