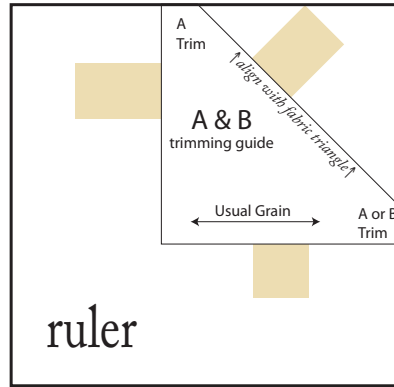
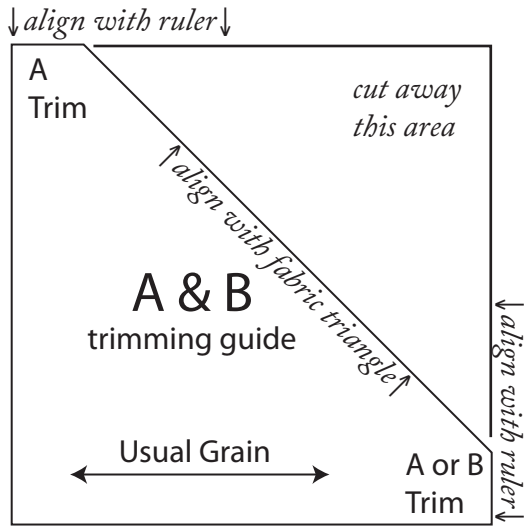
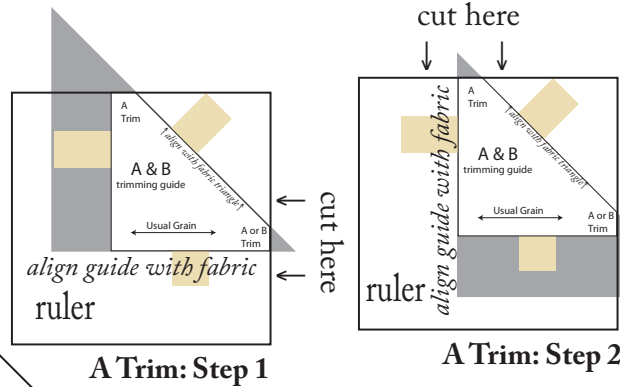
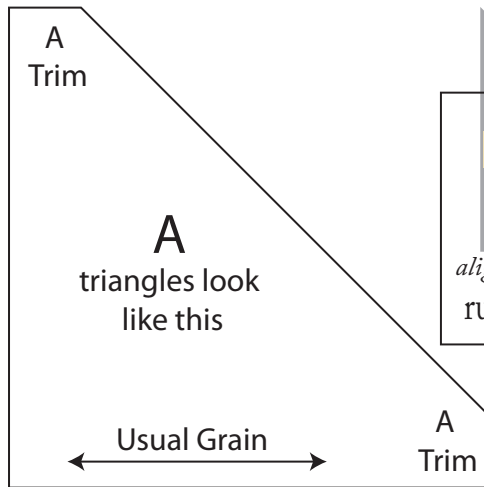


A or B Point Trims Using a Paper Guide Taped to a Ruler



Note that you can use this guide to trim points of any size triangle or any shape having a 45-degree angle.

To make an A & B Point Trimming Guide, start by printing this page at 100% size. Cut out the triangular guide at the top left of the page, noting the ruler alignment instructions before cutting them off. Tape the guide to a small rotary ruler with the blunted points even with the top and right edges of the ruler, as shown at left.



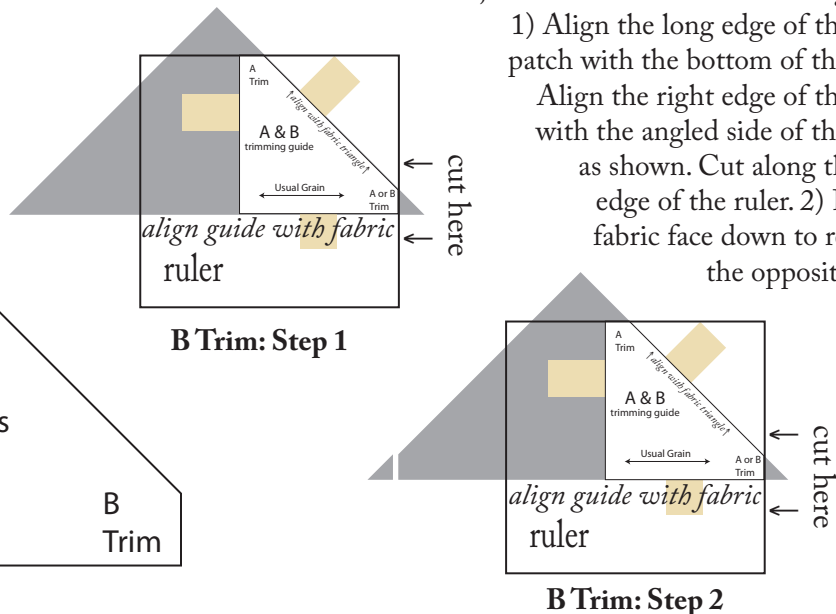
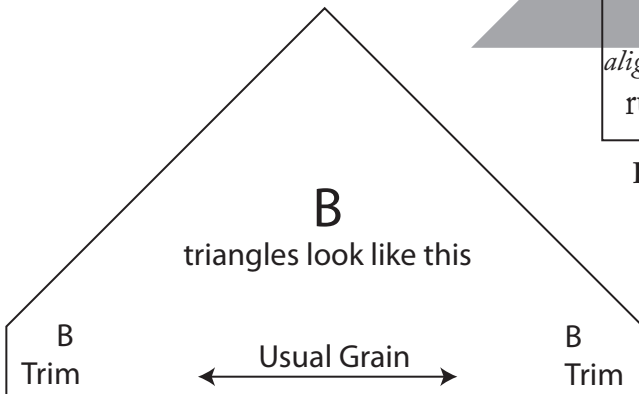
1) For A trims, align 2 sides of the fabric with the bottom and right sides of the paper guide. Trim at the ruler's right edge. 2) Slide the ruler up and to the left, aligning the left side of the guide with the left side of the triangle.

Trim the point that extends above the ruler, cutting along the top of the ruler.

For B trims, use the same A & B trimming guide.

1) Align the long edge of the fabric patch with the bottom of the guide.

Align the right edge of the fabric with the angled side of the guide, as shown. Cut along the right edge of the ruler. 2) Flip the fabric face down to repeat at the opposite point.
